Dress for Success Canada Foundation is a national charity dedicated to advancing gender equity and economic independence for women and non-binary individuals. Through no-cost pre-employment and job retention programs, we help participants thrive personally and professionally. With a nation-wide scope and sustainable funding, we strengthen the capacity of local affiliates to scale impact and create a more inclusive workforce across Canada. In 2024 Canadian affiliates collectively supported 10,343 women and non-binary individuals.

What We Do

Our 13 affiliates across Canada provide:

- Job Search Support: Resume help, LinkedIn profiles, mock interviews.
- Professional Attire: Styling and clothing for interviews and employment.
- Employment Retention: Ongoing mentorship, workplace skills, confidence-building.
- Financial Education: Tools for long-term economic independence.
- Leadership Development: Ambassadorship, public speaking, peer support.
